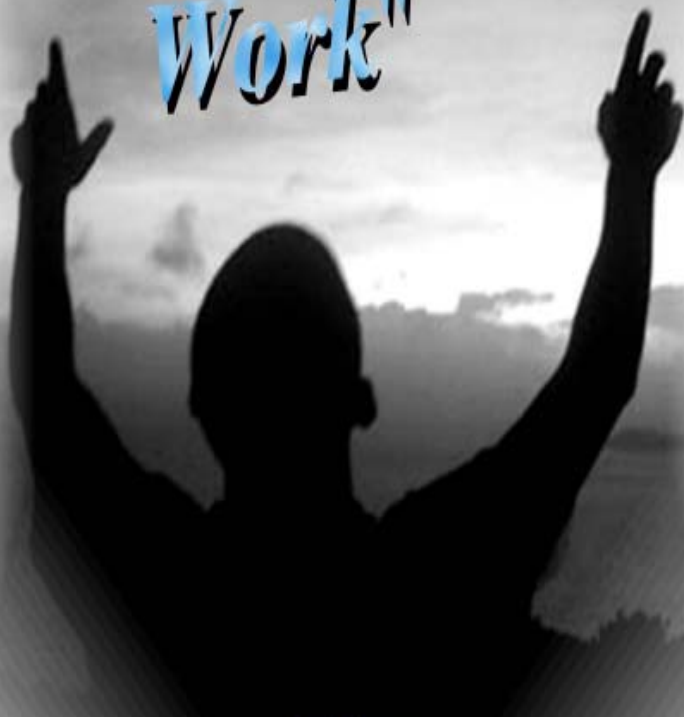

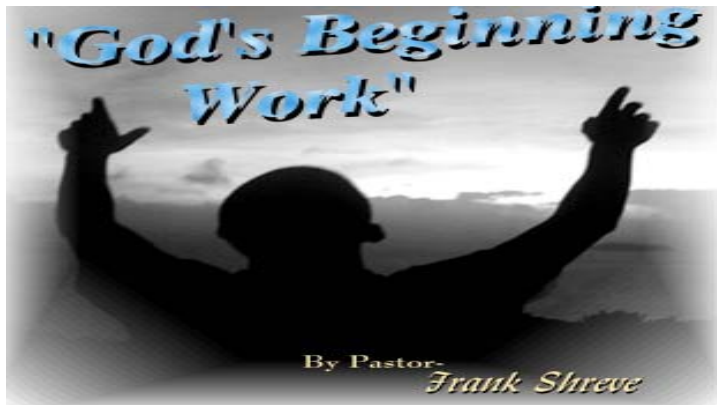

Phil. 1:6, ***“Being confident of this very thing that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ”.***

Paul was writing to Philemon encouraging him saying, God has begun a good work in you and is able to finish it. This is not saying that once God starts a work in a person that it is dependent on God how the work will end. What Paul was saying, God begins a good work in every believer, but it is up to the individual how that work will end. God will provide the necessary help and strength for us to complete the work if we will be determined to finish it.

I believe God wants to start a good work in us at the Upper Room Church beginning this year, but it depends upon what we will do with this work throughout the year.

It is like the parable of the men who were given talents by their master. It was up to each individual how he used the talents whether he succeeded or failed. Jesus gave the parable in Matt. 25:14-18, ***“For the kingdom of heaven is as a man traveling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. And unto one he gave five talents to another two and to another one to every man according to his several ability and straightway took his journey. Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same and made them five other talents. And likewise he that had received two he also gained two. But he that had received one went and dug in the earth and hid his lord’s money.”*** You will notice that it depended upon the servants how they used their lord’s money in what the outcome would be. It wasn’t up to their

master how the servants used their talents, their master had provided the money. It depended on them how they used it.

There are many people in the Bible where God began a work in them, but they didn't finish it the way God intended. Does that mean that God failed? No!! It means that those who didn't finish the work did not continue in the thing that God called them to do.

Samson was one of those men. Samson was in the lineage known as the judges. They ruled Israel during a period when there was no king and, "***Every man did that which was right in his own eyes.***" Judges 17:6 Had God not raised up the judges complete anarchy would have happened and made a shambles of the nation. The disappointing nature of Samson's career is strangely expressed in two statements.

The first came from the angel of the Lord as He addressed the woman who was to be Samson's mother. "***He shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.***" Judges 13:5 The second statement is found in the twenty fifth verse of the same chapter describing a period in Samson's early manhood. "***And the Spirit of the Lord began to move him at times in the camp.***"

Samson's whole career was an unfortunate example of a mission that began, but did not finish victoriously, or in the way that God wanted it to end.

I do not feel that Samson was foreordained to fall. I cannot believe that anyone is. Samson's downfall came through weakness of character that was allowed to go uncorrected. Certainly this young man had everything in his favor. His parents were of the most God-fearing people even though they



lived in times of apostasy. Samson was brought up well without question there was a family altar in his home. His

birth was in the atmosphere of the supernatural as the angel announced it. He gave instructions for his consecration as a Nazarite before he was even conceived. His mission in life was settled in heaven before he ever saw the light of day. Perhaps Samson's endowment with the Spirit came too easily for his own good. At any rate he never appeared to stand in awe at what God had done for him.

One fact of the whole story is that Samson's anointing had no apparent effect on his manner of life or his character. When the Spirit was upon him he was one person, but when the anointing subsided he was another. In between the times of God moving in his life, he did whatever pleased his carnal nature, whether it was right or not.

Like some today he mistakenly took for granted God's approval of his entire way of life because he was occasionally used of God. When we separate the super-natural working of the Holy Ghost from our Christian character, and our daily walk of holiness, we are headed for disaster. One of the amazing things about Samson's life was the company he kept. He spent most of his time with the Philistines, the enemy of the Israelites. He even turned to loose women. Never did he appear to seek out the fellowship of those who were prayerful and godly. Perhaps always being able to keep the upper hand over the Philistines made him overconfident. Despite his great feats we know he stayed too long in enemy territory and finally met his downfall.

Let no one think that he can retain his spirituality indefinitely if he makes bosom companions of the devil's crowd. Samson did not fall all at once. He successfully resisted Deliah's persuasion for a time, but finally he was worn down by constant pressure and gave away his Nazarite secret. This tragedy has been repeated often. It matters not how strong we may feel today, we are still human. If we do not retain the fullness of the Spirit we too may be worn down by physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual pressures to the point of falling. We can not afford any unguarded moments. The point we must not miss is that it was not the great obstacles that defeated Samson. A roaring lion was no more to him than a mouse would be to a cat. He disposed of a thousand men with a donkey's jawbone. He could not be imprisoned within a city even when the heavy gates were barred. He simply lifted the gates with their posts and carried them away to the top of the mountain as a testimony of the power of God. Samson fought against fierce formidable foes, but they could not overcome him. But the sweet talk of a scheming woman was the blow that caused him to fall.

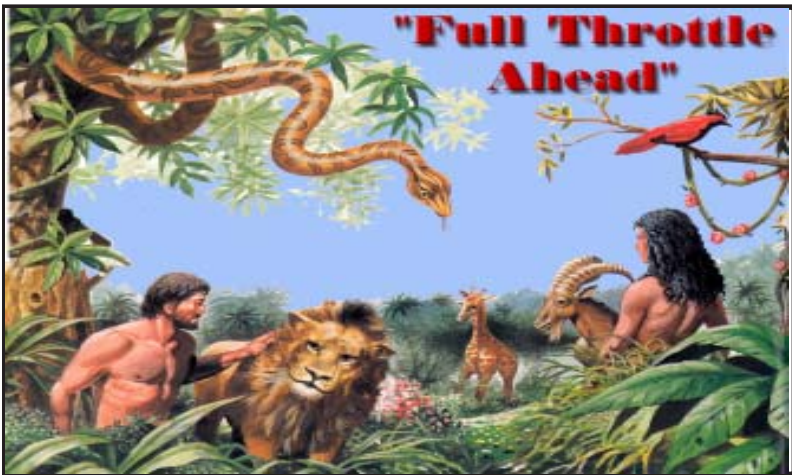

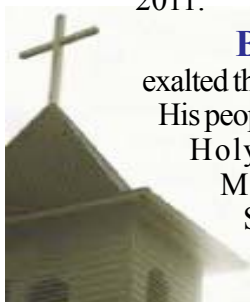

The first day Samson went to Deliah's house, he didn't dream that she was more dangerous than a lion or an army. We too must be on guard against things that seem harmless. We may be heroes against lions, but we can be ground to bits by a temptation that appears to be harmless.

Samson made a comeback in his final days and I am glad he received his power back. He became the strong man of days gone by. He slew more men at his death than in his life time, but what a pitiful spectacle he must have been. His eyes were punched out, he provided daily sport for his captors, he grinded meal for the enemy's food, and a little boy lead him around. But God's mercy allowed him a final victory. The sad part is he didn't march off the stage in a triumphant victory.

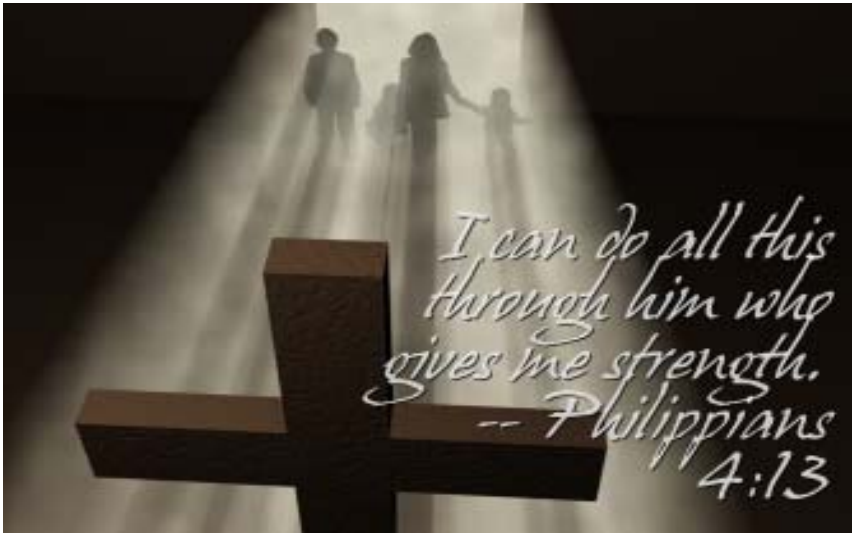
God does not want us to bow out of life the way Samson did.



Samson's main purpose in life was never fully accomplished. He did not complete the deliverance of Israel. He began, but fell in defeat before he finished what he was called to do. The Spirit of God began to move him, but in an hour of carelessness he lost the Divine touch.

The account of this ancient judge is recorded for a purpose. God wants us to see that even with a godly family background, a rich spiritual anointing, and the ability to accomplish great feats in His kingdom we still must fight with all our strength to stay in the center of God's will. We dare not let down our guard and try to coast along. Neither can the anointing of God be taken for granted or considered lightly. We must pass our days in the fear of God. We want to do more than just begin in this fight, we must want to finish the job God given us to do.

No one has to fail we all can be victorious. God gave the Lord Jesus Christ a work to be done and He finished it, regardless how much the devil tried to stop Him. In everything and in every way Jesus defeated the devil on every hand. 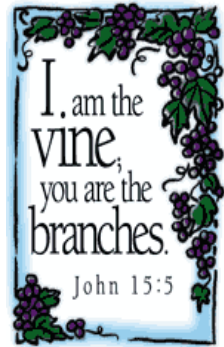
immediately he could speak again. Of course, Zacharias praised God for his son and for being able to speak again.
